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Week 5: Workforce Readiness: 21st Century Skills and Education Needed

Duration: 45 minutes

Week 5 Introduction (Video):

- Welcome Members back and briefly recap Week 4.
- Provide an overview of Week 5's focus on careers and the 21st century skills and education needed in the global climate change, transportation, and energy industries.
- Summarize this week's activities.

Objectives: The objectives of this session are to:

- Understand and explore 21st century education and skills needed in global climate change, transportation, and energy industries.
- Gain insights from career professionals' backgrounds and experiences.
- Identify skills and interests that connect to various global climate change, transportation, and energy.

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Career Professional Roundtable Questions

Theme "21st Century Education and Skills Needed in Global Climate Change, Transportation, and Energy"

Required Questions:

- 1. What inspired you to choose your career profession instead of other things?
- 2. How does your career relate to global climate change, transportation, and/or energy?
- 3. What is a typical work day look like for you?
- 4. How much education and/or training did you have to have?
- 5. What education and skills do you recommend young adults consider for future careers?
- 6. What do you find most interesting about your career?
- 7. Knowing what you know now, what advice would you give to your younger self?

Optional Questions:

- 8. What makes you a good leader?
- 9. Do you like/love your career? Why or Why not?
- 10. Are you still in the same career that you started out in or has it changed?
- 11. What does success mean to you?
- 12. What is your goal and what message do you want to leave for the world?
- 13. How do you make decisions, even when you experience criticism or push back?
- 14. What books have made the most significant impact on your career?
- 15. Did you choose your profession for the money or to make a change or both?
- 16. Did anyone ever call your idea stupid? If so, did that discourage you?
- 17. Did you ever consider quitting or changing jobs? Or were you determined to stay and reach your goal?
