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# Week 10: Wrap-up: Final Project Instructions and Program Evaluation

Duration: 45 minutes

#### Week 10 Introduction (Video):

- Welcome members to the LAST week in the 10-week program & recap Week 9.
- Congratulate the winners from the Week 9 Advocacy Debate Competition.
- Congratulate all members for completing the 10-week CoT program.
- Encourage members and facilitators to provide feedback and suggestions for improvement on the 10-week program by completing the online Program Evaluation forms.
- Provide the full CoT Final Project Competition details.
- Kahoot! Game Competition to assess global climate change knowledge

#### Objectives: The objectives of this session are to:

- Wrap up the 10-week CoT program.
- Summarize and assess teen education and awareness of the CoT program, global climate change, transportation, and energy.
- Provide details for the CoT Final Project Competition and review the **CoT Final Project Competition Guidelines**.

#### Facilitator Instructions:

- Set up:
  - Videos: Open an Internet window and have the Introduction video ready to play. There is no Learning video this week. The weekly session content and video can be found at: <a href="https://www.clubhouseatyourhouse.com/week10">https://www.clubhouseatyourhouse.com/week10</a>. Scroll down to the "Weekly CoT Session" section of the web page and click on the specific week.
  - o Virtual Facilitation:
    - Open the Zoom room at least 15 minutes before the start of the session.

    - Some teens may join individually and others may join in a group at a local club. This may present some challenges with individual exercises and activities. Ensure that teens in the same room still have access to electronic devices to complete their assignments.
    - Club/Organization facilitators may want to participate and help facilitate the discussion with the teens.
    - Take pictures and video clips of your group and email them to: <u>cot@bgcgw.org</u>.
  - o In-person facilitation:
    - Arrive at least 15-30 minutes before the start of the session to set-up and prepare.
    - Teens should have access to electronic devices for individual assignments.
    - Download and/or print the Final Project Group Member Worksheet to document all groups that intend to submit final projects (located at the end of Week 10 below and on the CoT website at https://www.clubhouseatyourhouse.com/week10).
    - Take pictures and video clips of your group and email them to: cot@bgcgw.org.
- Introduction Video: Begin the weekly session by playing the weekly BGCGW CoT Introduction video.

- Set-up: It is recommended to set up the teen space before the teens join, test the projector/TV connection and play the video to check the video and audio features
- Ensure that teens have access to electronic/mobile devices with an Internet connection.
- The video will welcome teen members to the program and provide a brief overview of the CoT Program, the calendar of events, and how the weekly sessions are designed.

- Learning Video: There is no learning video this week.

#### **Exercise or Activity: Kahoot! Game Competition**

The game will be based on the full 10-weeks of CoT programming based on global climate change, transportation, and energy. Object of the Game: Teen Members will compete against each other to see who will get the most points by answering CoT questions correctly and fast.

- Click Host Live to start a game with your teens.
- Start the game in Classic Mode.
- Provide the players the Game Pin.
- When all players have joined with their names showing. Start the game.
- o Facilitators must email 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place Kahoot! winner names to: cot@bgcgw.org.

#### Teens:

- Teens should download the Kahoot! Game App or use the link (<u>www.kahoot.it</u>) on their computers, tablets, or mobile devices.
- Teens should include their names in the app if they want to be considered for a prize.

#### Wrap Up:

o Submit Kahoot! Winners: (Facilitators) Email 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place Kahoot! winner names to: cot@bqcqw.orq.
